

# Impregnated terrace timber

<b>Maintenance</b>	LOBA ParkettSoap (maintenance cleaning, diluted 50-100mL/10L) LOBASOL Deck & Teak Oil (maintenance caring)

<b>Intensive cleaning</b>	LOBA Deck & Teak Refresh LOBA ParkettSoap (diluted 1:2)

<b>Maintenance</b>	<b>Cleaning</b> The timber can be easily cleaned using LOBA ParkettSoap.

	<b>Caring</b> Maintenance caring (also partially in heavily stressed areas) is to be carried out using LOBASOL Deck & Teak Oil. Fatty spots, black heel marks and other heavy stains will hereby be removed. Slight damages to the base oil will be repaired.

	<b>Repairing damages</b> During use slight damages to the base oil will appear, which can be removed (also partially) by revision using LOBASOL Deck & Teak Oil. For this the damaged areas are to be cleaned with LOBA ParkettSoap (1:2 diluted) and a green pad. After drying the areas are to be revised using LOBASOL Deck & Teak Oil. The floor can be used again after drying over night.

<b>Intensive cleaning</b>	To remove heavy stains and dirt which is not removable during maintenance, an intensive cleaning procedure using LOBA Deck & Teak Refresh can be carried out. This will bring back the natural shade of greyed timber. Alternatively LOBA ParkettSoap 1:2 diluted with water can be used (as intensive cleaner without de-greying effect). The timber is to be mechanically treated with the appropriate cleaning solution and a pad or a brush and subsequently rinsed with clear water. Since the timber will be strongly leached by this procedure, a subsequent treatment with LOBASOL Deck & Teak Oil is obligatory.

<b>Notes</b>	Wood is a natural material. The frequency of the mentioned caring measures are to be adjusted according to local conditions, i.e. mechanical stress, weather- and climate conditions, etc.
